





















Why Pray for the Least Reached?

1. Prayer obeys Jesus' command to ask the Lord of the Harvest to send out workers.
2. Prayer brings us into God's presence, which changes us.
3. Prayer reveals to us God's plans so we can cooperate with Him in them.
4. Prayer invites God's participation and presence in the process.
5. Prayer removes hindrances to the gospel.
6. Prayer prepares the hearts of unbelievers to hear the good news.
7. Prayer releases resources necessary to accomplish the task.
8. Prayer insures protection for workers and their work.
9. Prayer releases spiritual power to fulfill the call.
10. Prayer exercises divine authority to change situations & people.
11. Prayer IS the battle!
12. Prayer maintains the victory.

How Do I Pray?

SEE: Pray that believers will see the hearts among every least-reached people group who are ready for harvest (John 4:35).

SEND: Pray the Lord of the Harvest sends laborers among these "no choice" peoples (Luke 10:2).

UNITY: Pray that the Lord will help the Body of Christ labor together in the unity of the Spirit with the bond of peace (1 Cor. 3:9).

SUPPLY: Pray that God will supply and multiply "seed for the sower and bread for the eater" (2 Cor. 9:8-11).

SUCCESS: Pray for 100-fold fruit that remains for His glory & transforms each group (Matt. 4:20).
