

Trail of Ascension

Instructions: Use the following prayer queues to pray unto the Father and flow in the Spirit.

1 NUMBER ONE

Denotes absolute singleness. Pray for God to be our “One Thing,” that we have no other gods before Him.

Hear, O Israel: the Lord our God, the Lord is one. Deuteronomy 6:4

2 NUMBER TWO

Symbolizes witness and support. Pray for your personal life to be a witness to others and that many would come along side workers of the Lord in supporting them with prayer, encouragement, and financial blessings.

Two cherubim guarded the Ark of the Covenant (Exodus 25:22).

Two witnesses establish truth (Matthew 26:60).

The disciples were sent two by two (Luke 10:1).

Two are better than one, because they have a good reward for their toil. Ecclesiastes 4:9

3 NUMBER THREE

Signifies completion or perfection, and unity. Pray for unity among the body of Christ.

Three is the number of persons in the Trinity.

Many significant events in the Bible happened on “the third day” (Hosea 6:2).

Jonah spent three days and three nights in the belly of a fish (Matthew 12:40).

Jesus’ earthly ministry lasted three years (Luke 13:7).

Jesus answered them, “Destroy this temple, and in three days I will raise it up.” John 2:19

4 NUMBER FOUR

Relates to the earth. Pray for direction for believers and the world around you: nature, animals, etc.

Earth has four seasons: winter, spring, summer, fall.

There are four primary directions: north, south, east, west.

Four earthly kingdoms (Daniel 7:3).

Parable with four types of soil (Matthew 13).

He will raise a signal for the nations and will assemble the banished of Israel, and gather the dispersed of Judah from the four corners of the earth. Isaiah 11:12

5 NUMBER FIVE

A Number associated with grace. Pray for multiplied grace over yourself, ministry, and your sphere of influence.

Five Levitical offerings (Leviticus 1-5).

Jesus multiplied five loaves of barely to feed 5,000 (Matthew 14:17).

Portions were taken to them from Joseph’s table, but Benjamin’s portion was five times as much as any of theirs. And they drank and were merry with him. Genesis 43:34

6 NUMBER SIX

The number of man. Pray for all men to recognize their need for a Savior and King.

Adam and Eve were created on the sixth day (Genesis 1:31).

God created the whole world in six days and rested on the seventh. (Genesis 1).

The cities that you give to the Levites shall be the six cities of refuge, where you shall permit the manslayer to flee. Numbers 35:6

7 NUMBER SEVEN

Refers to the number of God, divine perfection or completeness. Praise the Lord for his completion and perfect will.

On the seventh day, God rested after completing the creation (Genesis 2:2).

God's Word is pure, like silver purifies seven times in the fire (Psalm 12:6).

Seven demons went out from Mary Magdalene, symbolizing total deliverance (Luke 8:2).

When you buy a Hebrew slave, he shall serve six years, and in the seventh he shall go out free, for nothing. Exodus 21:2

8 NUMBER EIGHT

May signify new beginnings, although many scholars don't attribute any symbolic meaning to this number. Pray for men to accept the Lord's forgiveness and move on in the hope of new beginnings.

Eight people survived the flood (Genesis 7:13, 23).

Circumcision took place on the eighth day (Genesis 17:12).

Eight days later, his disciples were inside again, and Thomas was with them. Although the doors were locked, Jesus came and stood among them and said, 'Peace be with you.' John 20:26

9 NUMBER NINE

May mean fullness of blessing, although many scholars don't assign any special meaning to this number either. Pray that the Lord would fulfill your requests and bring about His fullness in your life and others'.

There are nine fruits of the Spirit (Galatians 5:22-23).

But the fruit of the Spirit are love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control; against such things there is no law. Galatians 5:22-23

NUMBER TEN

Relates to human governments and law. Pray for your government and leaders.

10 The Ten Commandments were the Tablets of the Law (Exodus 21:1-17, Deuteronomy 5:6-21).
Ten tribes made up the northern kingdom (1 Kings 11:31-35).

And he [Boaz] took ten men of the elders of the city [as judges] and said, 'Sit down here.' So they sat down. Ruth 4:2

NUMBER ELEVEN

11 Relates to the irresponsibility of breaking the Law, which brings disorder and judgment; falling short or lacking. Pray for humility to recognize your short comings and then to accept healing.

The Tower of Babel men rebelled and God judged (Genesis 11).

John saw 11 things in connection with the final judgment (Revelation 20:12-14).

Then they cast lots, and the lot fell to Matthias; so he was added to the 11 apostles. Acts 1:26

NUMBER TWELVE

Relates to divine government. Pray for the King of Kings to take His rightful place on earth.

12 The 12 tribes of Israel (Revelation 7).
The 12 apostles (Matthew 10:2-4).

It [the New Jerusalem] had a great, high wall, with twelve gates, and at the gates twelve angels, and on the gates the names of the twelve tribes of the sons of Israel were inscribed...And the wall of the city had twelve foundations, and on them were the twelve names of the twelve apostles of the Lamb. Revelation 21:12-4
